Walk-in Immunization Clinics for Children Birth – 18 Years

Tip of the Month: Only 2 doses of HPV vaccine are required if the first dose is started between ages 11-14. 3 doses are needed if you start after 15 years of age.

Patients MUST BRING:

1. Child's Shot Record
2. Child's Insurance Card (if they have insurance)
3. Parent's ID
