

Position: Lead Poisoning Case Investigator (Registered Sanitarian)

Basic Qualifications:

- Bachelors Degree in Public Health, Environmental Health, Engineering, Natural/Physical/Life Science or related field
- Possession of a current Registered Sanitarian license issued by the state of Ohio
- Credentialed as a Health Homes Specialist by the National Environmental Health Association (NEHA)
- Strong communication (both oral and written) and organizational skills
- Understanding of environmental hazards in homes and their impact on health behaviors
- A valid driver's license and reliable transportation are required

Preferred Qualifications

- Strong background in environmental toxicology, environmental epidemiology, public health, health promotion, or health planning.
- Experience in environmental lead exposure including blood-level investigations and lead poisoning prevention.

Responsibilities:

- 1 Conduct interviews with parents or guardians of all children whose blood-lead levels test 5 mcg/dL or higher
- 2 Conduct environmental assessments of houses, schools and daycares where clients with elevated BLLs live or spend a majority of their time; write report of findings for each location
- 3 Utilize the Healthy Homes and Lead Poisoning Surveillance System (HHLPSS) to conduct case management activities
- 4 Follow-up with clients to ensure environmental hazards are being mitigated safely
- 5 Provide education on Healthy Homes and lead poisoning prevention; interact with health professionals to encourage screening of children at risk for lead poisoning.
- 6 Coordinate and/or participate in community efforts to promote Healthy Homes initiatives; market the HUD program through community awareness activities
- Assist with the development and implementation of HUD program policies, procedures, and strategies to reduce childhood lead poisoning
- 8 Enforce local lead ordinances in accordance to home remediation
- 9 Prepares letters to providers and parents for children with elevated BLLs as required by program guidelines; tracks letter actions for returns and re-sends
- 10 Coordinates with health case manager, physicians, state and local agencies, etc. as appropriate; tracks progress of individual cases through time, in consultation with health case manager

Other Responsibilities: Represent the Health Department to other partnering agencies, community organizations, and the public. Answer phone, participates on internal and external committees, and performs other duties as assigned.
