



## Position: Community Health Worker

### Basic Qualifications:

- High school diploma or G.E.D.
- Proficient oral and written communication skills
- An understanding of the issues that women from minority, disadvantaged, or underserved populations face when accessing health care
- A valid OH/MI driver's license and reliable transportation are required

### Preferred Qualifications:

- Certification as a Community Health Worker

### Responsibilities:

1	Conducts neighborhood outreach activities targeting vulnerable, underserved populations to find pregnant women who are not connected to prenatal care; networks with community members and neighborhood leaders
2	Enrolls pregnant women in the Pregnancy Pathway and connects them to prenatal care
3	Works with clients and their families throughout the pregnancy to reduce barriers to care
4	Utilizes the Partners for a Healthy Baby curriculum as the standard of care for home visitation and other interactions
5	Educates clients about the importance of prenatal care; nutrition and vitamins; safety needs; risks of smoking, drugs and alcohol; signs of labor; stress and depression; and issues related to fatherhood
6	In the last trimester of the pregnancy, helps clients prepare for delivery; discusses signs of labor, acquires a car seat, assesses the safety of the home and ensures that the baby has an appropriate crib
7	Works with insurance and Medicaid Managed Care to ensure appropriate coverage for clients
8	Connects the client to social and health services as required; assists in the completion of paperwork
9	Consistently completes appropriate forms throughout the Pathways and faxes forms to the HCNO office
10	Communicates with client's health care providers and insurers as necessary to provide coordination of care
<b>Other Duties &amp; Responsibilities:</b>	Attends Care Coordinator meetings as scheduled, and performs other duties as assigned.
