



Position: Community Health Worker

This position is responsible for conducting outreach activities in the community targeting the adolescent population. Responsibilities include providing teen life planning education in a group and/or one on one setting, assisting the teens with the completion of a life plan, assist teens and their families with meeting identified social determinate of health needs, referring families to available community resources, and complete the appropriate documentation for program reporting.

Basic Qualifications:

- High school diploma or G.E.D.
- Proficient oral and written communication skills
- An understanding of the issues that women from minority, disadvantaged, or underserved populations face when accessing health care
- A valid OH/MI driver's license and reliable transportation are required

Preferred Qualifications:

- Certification as a Community Health Worker

Responsibilities:

- Conducts neighborhood outreach activities.
- Build relationships with community members and community organizations.
- Implement the Teen Life Planning Program.
- Educate adolescents about life planning.
- Work with adolescents and their families to reduce barriers.
- Connect adolescents and their families to social and health services.
- Document program participation.
