COVID-19 April 24 Update

The COVID-19 numbers for Lucas County for today, April 24, are as follows:

- 1029 total cases
 - 987 confirmed cases
 - 42 probable cases
- 74 deaths
 - 64 confirmed deaths
 - 10 probable deaths
- 426 male cases
- 603 female cases
- The ages range from 3 to 101

The new deaths reported today represent a male in his 80s, two females in their 70s and a female in her 80s.
