The COVID-19 numbers for Lucas County for today, April 28, are as follows:

- 1190 total cases
 - 1151 confirmed cases
 - 39 probable cases
- 100 deaths
 - 92 confirmed deaths
 - 8 probable deaths
- 493 male cases
- 697 female cases
- The ages range from 3 to 101

The deaths reported today represent one male in his 20's, one male in his 60's, one male in his 80's, one male in his 90's, one female in her 50's, three females in their 60's, five females in their 80's and two females in their 90's.
