COVID-19 April 29 Update

The COVID-19 numbers for Lucas County for today, April 29, are as follows:

- 1217 total cases
 - 1178 confirmed cases
 - 39 probable cases
- 104 deaths
 - 96 confirmed deaths
 - 8 probable deaths
- 503 male cases
- 714 female cases
- The ages range from 3 to 101

The new deaths reported today represent a male in his 60's, a male in his 70's, a female in her 50's and a female in her 60's.
