COVID-19 April 7 Update

There will be no daily briefing today, April 7.

Toledo-Lucas County Health Department Commissioner Eric Zgodzinski on March 31 [announced](#) the creation of an online form for Lucas County residents to report suspected symptoms of COVID-19. The form, which was created through a partnership between the health department and the University of Toledo, can be found at this link:

Mr. Zgodzinski announced today that the online form could now also be used by residents in Fulton and Wood counties to report suspected symptoms of COVID-19.

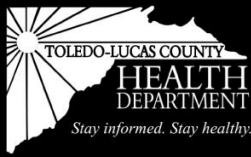
A map of Lucas County showing confirmed COVID-19 cases by zip code can be found at lucascountyhealth.com/coronavirusupdates/.

- 353 total cases
- 17 deaths
- 172 male cases
- 181 female cases
- The ages range from 3 to 98

The two most recent deaths reported today represent one male in his 50s and one female in her 80s.
