## COVID-19 April 9 Update

Toledo-Lucas County Health Department Commissioner Dr. Eric Zgodzinski and Toledo Fire & Rescue Chief Brian Byrd held a virtual briefing at 3:30 p.m., today, April 9, via Zoom, to give an update on the local response and precautionary measures to COVID-19. The COVID-19 numbers for Lucas County for today are as follows:

- 411 total cases
- 18 deaths
- 192 male cases
- 219 female cases
- The ages range from 3 to 98

The most recent death announced today represents a female in her 60s.
