### **COVID-19 May 4 Update**

**NOTE:** As the Emergency Operations Center continues to virtualize and re-assign members back to original work environments, please be advised beginning tomorrow, Tuesday, May 5, 2020, Public Information process will return to normal operations. All COVID-19 related requests will go to Shannon Lands at the Toledo Lucas County Health Department. Daily case numbers will continue to be released by the TLCHD for the foreseeable future.

Requests for Lucas County should go to Mark Reiter and requests for City of Toledo should go to Ignazio Messina. Gretchen DeBacker, Legislative Director at the City of Toledo, will return to her duties at the City. Chrys Peterson's contract for her role as Communication Advisor to EOC has also been suspended. Both will remain as general advisors and support for the communication team on a pro bono basis for a number of weeks as the transition back to normal operations occurs.

The COVID-19 numbers for Lucas County for today, May 4, are as follows:

- 1427 total cases
  - 1357 confirmed cases
  - 70 probable cases
- 124 deaths
  - 107 confirmed deaths
  - 17 probable deaths
- 576 male cases
- 851 female cases
- The ages range from 3 to 101

The deaths reported today represent one male in his 70's, one male in his 80's, one female in her 70's and one female in her 80's.
