**Lucas County COVID-19 Update**

The Lucas County COVID-19 numbers for today,  
are as follows:

- 2108 total cases
  - 1931 confirmed cases
  - 177 probable cases
- 214 deaths
  - 185 confirmed deaths
  - 29 probable deaths
- 841 male cases
- 1267 female cases
  - Ages range from <1 to 109
- 12,823 total tests performed\*\*

\*\*Includes all (resident & non-resident) COVID-19 viral nasal swab tests performed in Lucas County (hospital & community testing sites). This number does not include Lucas County residents tested in other jurisdictions.

The most recent deaths reported today represent: 1 female in 70s, 2 females in 80s, 1 female in 90s, 1 male in 60s, 2 males in 80s.
