**Lucas County COVID-19 Update**

The Lucas County COVID-19 numbers for today, are as follows:

- 2394 total cases
  - 2200 confirmed cases
  - 194 probable cases
- 266 deaths
  - 231 confirmed deaths
  - 35 probable deaths
- 964 male cases
- 1430 female cases
  - Ages range from <1 to 109
- 20,070 total tests performed\*\*

\*\*Includes all (resident & non-resident) COVID-19 viral nasal swab tests performed in Lucas County (hospital & community testing sites). This number does not include Lucas County residents tested in other jurisdictions.

The most recent deaths reported today represent: 1 female in 70s, 1 female in 80s, 1 male in 50s, 1 male in 60s, and 3 male in 70s.
