Lucas County COVID-19 Update

The Lucas County COVID-19 numbers for today, are as follows:

- 2540 total cases
 - o 2341 confirmed cases
 - o 199 probable cases
- 284 deaths
 - o 246 confirmed deaths
 - o 38 probable deaths
- 1026 male cases
- 1514 female cases
 - o Ages range from <1 to 109
- 25,299 total tests performed**

The Health Department recommends residents continue preventive measures, in order to slow the spread of COVID-19 through:

- Wearing a mask or face covering around others and in public (if possible)
- Social distance, 6-feet apart
- Washing hands frequently
- Stay home when sick
