Lucas County COVID-19 Update

The Lucas County COVID-19 numbers for today, are as follows:

- 2722 total cases
 - 2523 confirmed cases
 - 199 probable cases
- 287 deaths
 - 249 confirmed deaths
 - 38 probable deaths
- 1091 male cases
- 1631 female cases
 - Ages range from <1 to 109
- 26,713 total tests performed**

**Includes all (resident & non-resident) COVID-19 viral nasal swab tests performed in Lucas County (hospital & community testing sites). This number does not include Lucas County residents tested in other jurisdictions.

In order to slow the spread of COVID-19, the Health Department recommends residents continue preventive measures through:

- Wearing a mask or face covering around others and in public (if possible)
- Social distance, 6-feet apart
- Washing hands frequently
- Stay home when sick
