Lucas County COVID-19 Update

The Lucas County COVID-19 numbers for today, are as follows:

- 6153 total cases
 - 5896 confirmed cases
 - 257 probable cases*
- 334 deaths
 - 295 confirmed deaths
 - 39 probable deaths
- 2600 male cases
- 3553 female cases
 - Ages range from <1 to 109
- 49,253 total tests performed**

*Additional probable cases reported on this date include both recent cases and previous cases recently confirmed by TLCHD and ODH epidemiologists as meeting the CSTE Probable Case definition.

**Includes all (resident & non-resident) COVID-19 viral nasal swab tests performed in Lucas County (hospital & community testing sites). This number does not include Lucas County residents tested in other jurisdictions.
